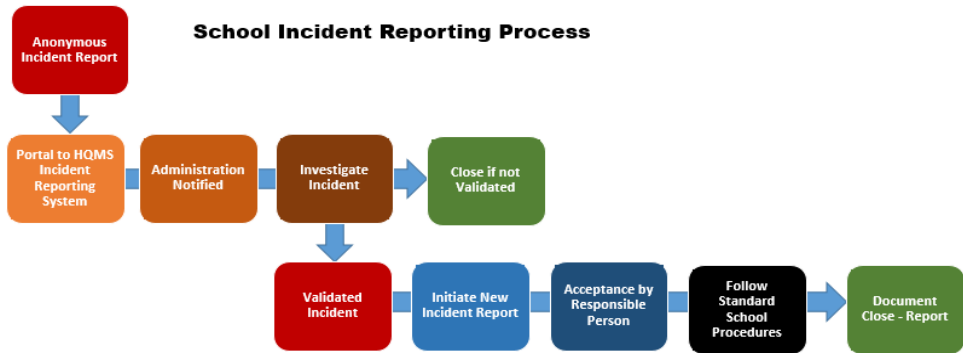

Step 3

The school district can generate reports based on the incident type as defined by the Florida Department of Education. This includes incidents for Alcohol and Arson through Vandalism and Weapons Possession.

Report Incident – Take Action – Validate – Notify – Implement Corrective Actions – Document all Steps – Report

Benefits of the Incident Reporting System

- **Address threats/suspicious activity systematically.**
- **Notify administration of the threat or incident.**
- **Take immediate action steps to address the threat.**
- **Add attachments such as photos, videos, or social media posts to the action step.**
- **Document each step you have taken to resolve the issue.**
- **Hold staff and authorities accountable for their actions.**
- **Report of actual incidents/threat to the district**
